Key Achievements 2024/25

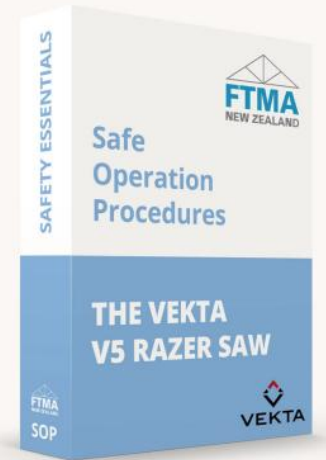
- Successful FTMA Conference 2025.
